Final traded price for the period; structural anchor.

Lower structural band showing available downward space.

Downside Band

Behavioural zone representing structural weakness.

E**Emotional Strength (ES)**

Measure of emotional load behind market movement.

Estimated Time (Hours)

Duration for which structural condition remains active.

F**Falling Emotional Strength**

Indicates emotional weakening or rising stress.

H**High Swing Volume**

Strong participation behind a rally or drop.

L**Large Swing Range**

High volatility and strong emotional reaction.

M**Market Equilibrium (Pivot)**

Structural balance point of the index.

Behavioural midpoint determining room to test projections.

Positive Emotional Strength

Indicates confidence or stability.

Indicates emotional recovery or stabilization.

Indicates strengthening structural balance.

Behavioural interpretation of rallies and drops.

T**Total Number of Shares Traded (Volume)**

Represents participation intensity.

Upper structural band showing available upward space.

Upside Band

Behavioural zone representing structural strength.

W**Weak Emotional Strength**

Indicates tension, fear, or instability.

Z**Zones (Strength & Weakness)**

Strength zone = Above; Weakness zone = Below.
